Article I

election of officers

To choose all necessary Village District Officers for the ensuing year.

Article II

Operating Budget

To see if the Village District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$108,921 for General District Operations.

Article III

temporary loans in anticipation of taxes

To see if the Village District will vote to authorize the District Commissioners to incur debts for temporary loans in anticipation of taxes.

Article IV

Contingency Fund

To see if the Village District will vote to establish a Contingency Fund for the current year for unanticipated expenses that may arise, and appropriate the sum of \$15,000, with said funds to come from unassigned fund balance. Any appropriation left in the Contingency Fund at the end of the year will lapse to the General Fund.

Article V

Establish Capital Reserve Fund

To see if the village district will vote to establish a Sawyer Village District Dam Capital Reserve Fund under the provisions of RSA 35:1 for the maintenance, repair, and required upgrades and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$15,000 to be placed in this fund, with said funds to come from Unassigned Fund Balance. Further, to name the Commissioners as agents to expend from said fund. Commissioners Recommend. (Majority Vote Required)

Article VI

Accept Unanticipated Money

Shall the village district accept the provisions of RSA 31:95-b providing that any village district at an annual meeting may adopt an article authorizing indefinitely, until specific rescission of such authority, the commissioners to apply for, accept and expend, without further action by the village district meeting, unanticipated money from a state, federal, or other governmental unit or a private source which becomes available during the fiscal year? (Majority vote required).
