- Meeting came to order at 6:00 PM. Minutes from the May 16, 2012, read and accepted.
- Dam: Water lowered one foot because of all the rain we have had. The district still has not heard from the state about the dam inspection.
- Beaches: Put sand down on some of the beaches. All beaches have been raked and will be raked again before July 4th. The state posted about part of the area near Fourth Beach being a Loon Sanctuary and restricted some boating.
- Roads: There have been heavy rains, but we have been keeping up with the roads and they have never gotten bad. Did some trenching on Deer Drive. Put in some cut-outs to protect the roads. No word on the road signs yet. Some places the grass has filled in the ditches. This is on-going work.
- Treasurer's Report:

Approximately \$6,000 spent on the repair of the district building. We are under budget in all areas.
