

Approved Library Trustees Minutes

November 1, 2010

Gilmanton Corner Public Library

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 PM by Chairman Tom Scribner. Trustees in attendance were Tom Scribner and Phyllis Buchanan; absent was Anne Kirby, seated in her place was alternate Deb Chase. Others in attendance were Librarian Linda Hudzeic, Judith Bakos, Barbara Angevine, Becky Ronstadt, and Diana McElwee. Due to Secretary Anne Kirby's absence, Diana McElwee volunteered to take minutes.

Minutes of October 18 Trustees meeting were approved.

Tom reported about the Selectmen's meeting he attended on October 25, 2010. He informed them of the pending appeal to the community for supplies and money to insulate the library building, upgrade the electrical system, and install venting. Selectmen seemed amenable to paying for the parts of the project not fully funded by donations.

Tom reported on the removal of plaster that was lying on the false ceiling of the library. The ceiling is clear and ready to be insulated.

The wish list for the aforementioned project will be posted on the Town web site, at both post offices, both markets, and placed in local newspapers. Tom will check with the schools to see if it can be included in their newsletters. He will also see if it can be posted at the Year Round Library.

Deb suggested adding an introductory paragraph to the wish list. She will confer with Tom to complete the project. Other suggestions included adding that donations should be sent to the library's PO Box c/o Linda.

Barb Angevine suggested that window insulation kits be added to the wish list. Tom will measure the windows and make that addition.

Library's report was next on the agenda. Linda submitted the statistics for October. She also reported that we have \$258 of donated money that was earmarked for purchasing books. She asked for permission to spend that money using the new library debit card. Moved by Tom, seconded by Deb, ayes all.

Barb Angevine reported that Steve will start the next bookcases in December. Linda asked to be notified of that event.

Becky Ronstadt volunteered her barn for library storage. The Adirondack chairs will be kept there over the winter.

Phyllis reported that 45-50 children trick-or-treated at the library this year.

Next meeting will be held Wednesday, December 1, at 4:00 PM.
