Board of Commissioners' Monthly Meeting
August 19, 2010

Present: Bob Dow, Dana Twombly, Rich Bakos, Paula Tarantino, and Paula Adams

- Meeting came to order at 6:00 PM.
- Motion made and seconded to approve minutes from meeting of July 15, 2010.
- Dam: No word from the state. No inspection of the dam yet. Dana will give a call to see what's going on.
- Beaches: Beaches have been raked and mowed. They will be done one more time and will be ready for the weekend.
- Roads: There have been no washouts and no heavy rains. Culverts have been cleaned. Road side mowing will start after Labor Day. Will set up date for trenching and roadside trimming of trees for winter plowing. Bob talked to town Road Agent about cleaning culverts that are their responsibility. Usually town does trenching in August. He has also talked to the Planning Board about the trailer at Beach 6. It does not have a permit showing.
- Treasurer's Report: Propane tank will be filled for winter at the District Meeting House. Insurance for the district has been paid. On the agenda for next month's meeting the insurance policy will be gone over to ensure correct coverage.

- Open Forum: Testing results from the water testing show high amounts of ecoli where the brooks come into the lake. At the dam where the water goes out, it is not high.

Discussion about a sticker program for boats to show they belong to a resident of the lake. This will be brought up at the Annual Budget Meeting.
