Present: Marion McIntyre, Pete Osler and Candace Daigle, Trustees; Carl Moorehead.

Budget: Received \$250 extra this year from town. Carl is starting to do work that could be categorized as beautification versus maintenance. We will ask that he differentiate in his billing so that P. Osler can correctly identify payments. We carried forward \$1400 towards a beautification project this year.

Maintenance: Last bill of 2000 came in with \$1 per hour increase in Carl Moorehead's rate. We kept \$15 rate for that bill. On a motion by C. Daigle, seconded by P. Osler, it was voted unanimously to increase Carl's 2001 rate to \$16 per hour. The Trustees agreed that Carl has done a great job and has become very versatile with tree, stone and fencing work. It was noted that a lot of hours have been put into Hillside. There are perpetual care funds for that site and it is a large site for regular maintenance such as mowing.

Parsons: Barbara Angevine talked to M. McIntyre regarding donating or donating towards a gate for Parsons. M. McIntyre reminded the Trustees that one section of the south wall needs to be finished in order to erect a gate.

2001 Projects: P. Osler will contact K. Fife and ask for prices on:

- One wall at Tibbetts (Alton/north side)
- Complete south wall at Parsons and straighten gate posts/ask for gate reference
- Stage Rd wall

M. McIntyre will let Mrs. Angevine know that we are checking on prices for a gate and that we will let her know at prices we come up with.

Carl reports that he has started on both Crystal Lake and Copp cemeteries. He's replacing stones on the front wall of Crystal Lake that were knocked down by falling trees. He'll be taking care of gluing on a ball at Hillside that was pulled off by vandals. He'll be fixing barbed wire fence and hauling in some loam to fill in holes at Bosiak's. He'll be hauling in some loam at Guinea Ridge. He asked that we have someone look at a tree removal for Guinea Ridge. P. Osler will contact Chip Johnson and have him contact Carl directly.
