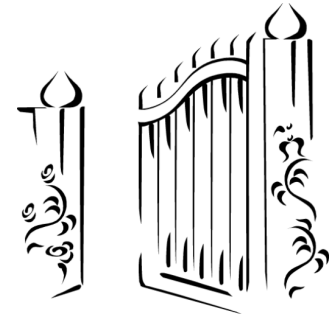




# TRUSTEES OF CEMETERIES

Meeting Minutes  
Wednesday, May 31, 2006, 7pm

Present: Trustees Marion McIntyre, Candace Daigle and Leonard Stockwell, Jr.

JR reported on his work cleaning out Sanborn cemetery. He also cleared/cleaned the path to the cemetery. He submitted pictures of the site for the records.

JR talked to Gerry Austin who said that he remembers hunting in the area of the small cemetery on the Billotta property (currently being called the Foster cemetery) and seeing an infant stone there many years ago. There is no apparent stone there now, but the site has been preserved on the subdivision plan as a cemetery. We may also investigate naming the site as Green for the Green family who previously owned the site.

The Trustees reviewed the Cemetery Rules draft. It was decided that more information will be sought from a funeral director regarding some of the minimum standard issues:

- Lot area necessary for multiple cremations
- Number of cremations per lot
- Is there room/do we need corner posts for every lot

We also have input coming from LGC on their review of the document. When the Regulations are adopted we'll send a copy to every owner of a new section lot in Buzzell.

Marion received a telephone call from Mrs. Tibbetts who was upset that Guinea Ridge had not been mowed for Memorial Day. Marion did call Carl and ask that it be taken care of. The Trustees have asked Carl in the past if he needs additional assistance. Might be wise to check with him again. At the end of the year Candace will provide Carl with a copy of the monies spent per site during that year as well as a copy of the upcoming year's maintenance schedule for his use. Marion also received a call regarding a Pine Grove lot. Candace will get both Marion and JR a list of contacts for other cemeteries.

JR reported that setting the posts at Hatie Smith's has been delayed at least 3 weeks because of the rainy spring. The landscaper is going to pick up the posts from Swenson's as well as install them. Trustees also discussed the naming of this site – trying to get back to an original owner's name.

Next meeting date will be set once information on the draft regulations is received.
