

Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, June 3, 2009, 7pm
Gilmanton Academy
503 Province Road

Present: Trustees Marion McIntyre, Candace Daigle and Leonard Stockwell, Jr.

Beech Grove: The 2009 Town Meeting voted to accept the cemetery. It can occur after their CD matures in June. C. Daigle has sent documents to Counsel to draft deed. The Association is currently having the gates sandblasted. The remaining funds (approximately \$4,900) will be turned over to the Town with the deed. The Trustees will need to amend their Regulations to add in Beech Grove.

Guinea Ridge-Carl Moorehead reports it's all cleaned up for the spring. There are 2 broken stones. He's stood them up and will repair later on. Nancy Jordan reports that no burial or stone occurred on their site because they felt it was too time consuming and costly to go through the Probate process. Candace will follow up with the Court to see if there's any way to simplify the process.

Budget - Paid three bills to Carl so far this year. Current budget is:

\$3,760 in Groundskeeping
\$100 in Office Supplies
\$2,500 in Repairs & Maint
\$998 in Trust Fund

Last year the Trustees discussed having the side gates (double drive thru and single walk thru) at Buzzell done this year. They preferred the lesser cost of \$3,590. The Repairs & Maint and Trust Fund would essentially cover this cost. JR will check with Norm Pinnette on the status of the quote.

The year-end report was forwarded to Dick Foss.

Signs: There are 10 signs to put up at Copp, Buzzell, Tibbetts, Sleeper, Parsons, Hillside, Friends, Lougee, Sawyer Lake and Beech Grove. M. Daigle may have enough signposts although they may need to be cut down. The trail/easement decals can also be placed.

Mary Butler: It does not look like Historical Society has stained Mary Butler fence yet. Candace will check w/John Dickey

Edgerly (1): JR reported the site looks fine.
