The Trustees reviewed current year expenditures, encumbrances from the 2002 budget and budget status.

M. McIntyre noted that the Lower Gilmanton Community Club had previously turned over the maintenance of the Mudgett site to the Historical Society. However, as the site was not being maintained, the Trustees will continue maintenance unless the Historical Society or some other entity steps forward to do so.

The Trustees will meet at 9am on September 1<sup>st</sup> at the Academy to view selected cemeteries.

Discussed possible interest of Buzzell Association to turn over maintenance to Trustees. C. Daigle will draft letter to President regarding same.

Trustees reviewed letter from and response to Mr. Alex regarding the improved condition of Kelley cemetery.

After the scheduled inspections, the Trustees will further consider current year expenditures, a 2004 budget appropriation request, contacting Kevin Fife regarding walls, purchasing gates, etc.
