Minutes of the Gilmanton Conservation Commission Work Session  
held Tuesday, 19 August 2008, 7:00 p.m. at the Academy

Present: Paula Gilman, Sue Hale de Seve, Erin Hollingsworth, Nanci Mitchell, Lisa Robinson, Brenda Sens, Dick de Seve

Nanci announced that our next meeting, scheduled for 9 September 2008 would have to be changed as that is election day. We decided to hold the meeting on Wednesday the 10<sup>th</sup> instead.

Dick moved to accept the Minutes of our August 12 meeting. Erin seconded the motion and all voted in favor.

- A. The Planning Board authorized the Planning Administrator to determine if seven outstanding items are satisfactorily met and if so the final plan can be signed for the Rague/Goulet subdivision. Nanci pointed out that there are discrepancies in the final plans and that instead of a title opinion they obtained title insurance. We decided to wait until the plans are corrected and Town Counsel reviews the title before we will approve the conservation easement.
- B. Crystal Lake Docks: The Downing's permit expired last year and they constructed their dock this year. It is smaller than the original plan. In view of the number of people who construct docks without bothering with a permit we decided to let this dock go.
- C. Gilmanton Land Crew: The first tasks for our volunteer group will be the staining and painting of the Stroud sign as well as its installation. The painting will take place on Tuesday and the installation on Sunday, after consultation with Paul Stroud about where he would like it. Everyone is invited to come and help. The stain is walnut and the lettering is in a light moss green. Everyone liked the colors and contrast. The next effort of the Land Crew will take place on Sunday, 14 September when work will be done on the Cogswell Mountain Trail behind the library.
- D. We looked at the Conservation Lands Map and made sure the road names corresponded to those on the 911 map of Gilmanton.
- E. Everyone worked on the mailing of the brochure concerning the Comprehensive Shoreline Protection Act.

The meeting ended at 9:40 p.m.
