- Motion made and seconded to accept minutes from September 20, 2012, meeting with changes.
- Dam: The new signs stating, "No motorized vehicles on the dam," have been put up. The state has taken out the boards.
- Beaches: Rafts and ropes have been taken in. New signs are up stating, "No boats on beaches."
