**September 15, 2011**

- Meeting came to order at 6:00 PM
- Minutes for August 18, 2011, read. Motion made and seconded to approve minutes.
- Dam: Boards were pulled for hurricane and replaced two days later.
- Beaches: Rafts will be pulled out of the water by the last weekend in September. Some beaches mowed.
- Roads: Road side mowing has been completed. Some ditching problems. They will be taken care of before winter. Grass has been mowed and the problems can now be seen. They seem to be normal on-going problems. Roads have been taken care of after each storm. Many stone berms have been cut and put in. No information on road signs yet.
- Treasurer's Report: General Building, there should be enough money in the budget to cover expenses for the remainder of the year. Roads expenditures will be close, depending on the amount of snow we have.

There should be enough in the budget to cover bills. There is a surplus in the dam account. Bring up at annual meeting so we don't have to have a new bond. See what the people want.

Treasurer's Report approved and seconded.

The complaint about an easement has been taken care of. Real Estate agents have been calling about the rules and regulations on the lake because of the recent property auctions. All but one lot sold.
