- Motion made and seconded to approve notes from July 21, 2011.
- Dam: No business
- Beaches: Beaches will be raked for Labor Day. Some complaints about the mowing on the beaches. Next year they will be mowed twice a month. Beach 2 is overgrown at the point. This will be taken care of. District received a bill for water testing for \$140. This was never voted on at the annual meeting and the State will be informed that the District will not be paying the bill.
