1. Elect chair

Mr. Willard moved to elect Mr. Forst as budget committee chair, seconded by Mr. Sawyer. Motion was unanimous.

Mr. Forst moved to elect Mr. Gianni as budget committee vice-chair, seconded by Mr. Daigle. Motion was unanimous.

There was a discussion about having the Local Government Center give an overview of SB2 government, and warrant articles at the April 18th meeting.

Mr. Willard raised the question of how much a special meeting will cost, since the teacher's raises were voted down.

Mr. Forst wanted to find a better way to let the public know when the Budget Committee meetings will be held because there have not been many people at the meetings.
