Effective Wednesday May 10th, 2017, the Gilmanton Police Department will begin a new service called "GOOD MORNING GILMANTON."

This service is designed to check the safety and welfare of the elderly or handicapped individuals within our community who live alone or have special needs. When a person decides to enroll in this program, the person or persons will sign up and agree to call in to the Gilmanton Police Department each day MONDAY through FRIDAY, between the hours of 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM. The person will just need to identify him or herself and state that they are checking in as part of the Good Morning Gilmanton program.

If the police department has not heard from a person enrolled in the program by 11:00 AM, contact will be attempted by telephone first. If there is no answer, a police officer will be dispatched to the residence to check the safety and welfare of the person. Persons enrolled in the program will be asked to provide the Police Department with a key to his or her residence. The key will be maintained in a secure location at the Police Department.

A copy of the enrollment form is attached to this cover letter. You will be required to contact the Gilmanton Police Department, and fill out the proper information for the program and turn it in to a staff member of the Gilmanton Police Department.
