Dear Selectmen:

The New Hampshire Division of Forests and Lands is planning a salvage operation to remove downed trees resulting from the late March 2017 nor'easter from 48 acres of the Sanborn State Forest in the town of Gilmanton, New Hampshire. Attached is a location map of the planned harvest for your reference.

The harvest will require transportation of forest products over town roads. Paul Perkins, Gilmanton Road Agent, will be contacted to discuss any impact to the roads from logging trucks.

We are in the early stages of planning this harvest, however due to the damage we anticipate offering for public bidding this summer. At that time you will be notified as to the timber volume sold and the successful bidder who will be responsible for payment of the timber tax.
