5:33 p.m. – Gilmanton Transfer Station

Present: Chairman Stephen McWhinnie, Selectman Michael Jean, Town Administrator Heidi Duval and Transfer Station Employees Ronald Nason, Matthew Abraham and Arthur Kempton.

Not Present: Selectmen Marshall Bishop

5:33 p.m. Chairman McWhinnie opened the meeting, roll call attendance of those present and voting (Chairman McWhinnie and Selectman Jean, Selectman Bishop absent)

Site Visit to the Transfer Station

The Board revisited the Transfer Station to view the clean-up efforts and discuss the layout of the facility and new compactor placement. The Selectmen determined they would prefer to leave the current compactor in place, and install the new compactor next to the current, on uphill side with two lanes of traffic between them. Ron Nason was asked to get the dimensions of the new compactor for further review, and the Road Agent was to be included in future conversations to see how much of the work the Highway Department could do. The possibility of using the current compactor for a recyclable was discussed, whichever is the most viable based on comparing expense/ revenue differences.

The Board will discuss the possibility of allowing more hours, on a short term basis, for employees to work outside of operating hours to finish clean-up the facility. Ron Nason was asked to have containers brought onsite for metal and glass, and to swap the construction debris container and glass, so that that the construction debris container stays dry and the Town therefore does not end up paying for water weight in disposal. Ron was also to look into placing an aluminum container behind the construction debris container, which he would have to move with the bobcat when the hauling company was coming to pick up the construction debris.

It was noted that future warrant article items may be another compactor and a new skid steer/ bobcat.

Ron Nason was to prepare figures for the recycling options and his proposed plans for the facility for the next regular Selectmen's meeting.

Adjournment: On a Motion by Chairman McWhinnie and seconded by Selectman Jean it was voted unanimously to adjourn at 6:06 p.m. (2-0)

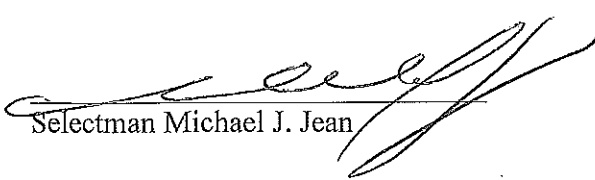

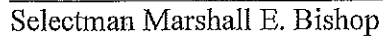
