Approval of Minutes -

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Involuntary Lot Merger Restoration:

Map 118 Lot 27 has requested an Involuntary Lot Merger Restoration pursuant to RSA 674:39-aa. Based on research and review from Assessing, Building/Zoning and Planning, no ownership since the forced merger has made any alterations to accept said merger so it is recommended you restore the two lots.

MOTION: On a motion by Chairman McWhinnie and seconded by Selectman Jean it was unanimously voted to grant the request to restore current Map 118 Lot 27 to its premerger status of two lots previously known as Map 0011 Lot 0002 Sub lot 5200 and 5300, which were involuntarily merged by the Town in 2005. These lots were merged due to at least one being non-conforming, and the restoration of these lots to their premerger status shall not be deemed to cure any non-conformity with the existing local land use ordinances. Any development or redevelopment of either lot shall conform to land use ordinances unless relief has been granted in accordance with such ordinances and State law. (3-0 Voice Vote - Chairman Mc Whinnie-yes, Selectman Bishop-yes and Selectman Jean-yes).
