- Interior portion of the Academy Building

Vice-Chairman Wilson- Are there projects at the Transfer Station that needs to be done?

Further discussion on specific uses vs non-specific items that may need to be stated at the public hearing.

The Assistant Town Administrator suggests a possible future facility maintenance position which could encompass building maintenance for all Town buildings, and grounds maintenance. The position would be justified but the qualified individual would need to be allowed to do the job and not be micromanaged by the Board. The current situation is that there is a competent staff member who researches, is the contact and brings forward the information and but there is frustration with the current set up, the issue in the past when one Board member takes the lead, the frustration from

contractors having to work in a difficult environment and the struggle of staff member that is presenting the information to the Board.

The Town Administrator would like to have a future discussion about the current facility maintenance vendor that is being used.

Further discussion on the Academy roof, combined positions or a mutual aid set up with other municipalities, for positions like the ACO, maintenance and building inspector, unfortunately sharing positions proofs to be difficult or not of any interest to other Towns.

The outcome of discussion: Look into the LCHIP information for the cupola and reach out to another vendor from Apex construction via Vice Chairman Wilson.

Adjournment: On a Motion by Chairman Bishop and seconded by Vice-Chairman Wilson it was voted unanimously to adjourn at 4:41 p.m. (2-0).
