19	MRI two years ago to find a replacement to T.A. Duval, the job ad then used and essay questions
20	that candidates had to answer during that process.

General Board consensus emerges around the idea of finding a temporary T.A. in light of the short 30-day notice given by T.A. Boré. Such an option would allow for the Board to have more time to go through the search for a new T.A. particularly as this time of the year is crunched with the Budget process.
