Present: Chairman Brett Currier, Selectmen Donald Guarino and Stephen McCormack, Town Administrator Arthur Capello, Administrative Assistant Stephanie Fogg. Also present Chief of Police Joseph Collins.

6:00 pm Chairman Currier opened the meeting, took attendance of those present and voting and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

(A)Non-Public Session per RSA 91-A:3,II (c)

MOTION: On a Motion by Selectman Guarino, and seconded by Selectman McCormack it was voted unanimously to go into Non-Public Session per RSA 91-A:3, II (c). (3-0 Voice Vote — Chairman Currier-yes, Selectman Guarino—yes, Selectman McCormack—yes).

Insurance for Academy Building - The Selectmen discussed and signed the Statement of Damage in the Insurance Package to receive a payment from the Insurance Company.

Election Day - The Town Clerk brought to the Selectmen's attention a question regarding election law, questioning whether Chairman Currier could work the day of the Election as a Selectman, where he is a write in candidate. "Electioneering" was brought up. The Selectmen asked for legal inquiry for general election law. It is within his rights as a Selectman to work the election that day.
