19	6:00 pm Chairman Guarino opened the meeting, took attendance of those present and voting and
20	led the Pledge of Allegiance.

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36	Pursuant to Article 17 in the Gilmanton Annual Report for 1992, (see attached), the properties
37	authorized for auction by the Town will be reviewed by the Conservation Commission and the
38	Planning Board and their recommendations brought forward to the Selectmen. This is the first o
39	two Public Hearings on these properties.
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41	Chairman Guarino said that the Planning Board recommended all of the properties be put up for
42	auction. Tracy Tarr of the Conservation Commission gave her recommendations to the Board of
43	Selectmen in May, 2015. The Conservation Commission's recommendations were to retain and

1 2	conserve Griffin Road Property, Sawtooth Road Property and South Road Property. See attached minutes of May 12, 2015 for Tracy's explanation.
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4 5	Brett Currier said that taking land and putting it into Conservation is taking land off the tax rolls. He said we have a lot of Conservation Land already in town. If we want the next generation to
6	stay in town, we need to have buildable property.
7 8	Mr. Kally thought the town had already yeard to eviction the properties, he agrees with Mr.
9	Mr. Kelly thought the town had already voted to auction the properties, he agrees with Mr. Currier.
10	Currier.
11	Peter Pinckney said that the South Road property should go back on the tax rolls, most of it is
12	wet, but there is 1 acre of well drained soil. Griffin Road is more than a mile from Rollins Pond,
13	it abuts recreational land on Bartlett Road and Pancake Hill Road. Properties that are put into
14	Conservation are "look don't touch", no provisions for any public access.
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16	There will be a second Public Hearing for discussion of the properties listed for auction in July,
17	2015.
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19	Chairman Guarino thanked everyone for their input and closed the Public Hearing for Auction
20	Properties.
