28 Leif and Mary Ellen Erickson were present at the hearing. Mr. Erickson explained that the home

- 29 was built in 1790, and ell was added, then a carriage barn and in 1857 the big barn was added.
- They are trying to keep the buildings as they are and have been. It is a working farm, they raise Highland Ponies. It is the second house out of the Historic District heading up Route 140 toward
- 31 Highland Ponies.32 the Iron Works.

The Selectman can grant from 25% to 75% tax relief of the assessed value of the barns to be included in the easement. This easement would give the owners some relief in continuing to
