Present: Chairman Rachel Frechette Hatch, Selectman Donald Guarino, Selectman Michael Jean, Town Administrator Paul Branscombe and Administrative Assistant Stephanie Fogg, Fire Chief Paul Hempel, and Police Chief Matt Currier.

5:30 pm Chairman Hatch opened the meeting, took attendance of those present and voting (Selectman Jean, Selectman Guarino, Chairman Hatch) and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Fire Department Command Vehicle Warrant Article – The Selectmen met to compare the Police Cruiser Ford Explorer and the current Fire Command Vehicle. After discussion, it was decided that the Fire Command Vehicle to be requested in the Warrant Article would be the Ford Expedition, available locally. The full body frame is more appropriate than the Ford Explorer (the uni-body frame on the Explorer cannot hold up in the same capacity over the time expected for use) and in keeping with what the Town has had for the last ten year. Most Fire Chief's in surrounding Towns have an Expedition or a Tahoe.

MOTION: On a Motion by Selectman Guarino and seconded by Chairman Hatch it was voted to accept the Expedition as the Fire Department Command Vehicle for the Warrant Article. (2-0-1, Chairman Hatch – yes, Selectman Guarino – yes, Selectman Jean – recused).

Adjournment: On a Motion by Chairman Hatch and seconded by Selectman Jean it was voted unanimously to adjourn at 6:00 pm (3-0).
