Highway Department:

Wage increase 6% which represents a 4.5% COLA and 1.5% merit for the following lines:

01-4311-680 – up to \$250 as there is still one position to fill

Highway & Streets

01-4312-693 – up to \$7,000 due to increase cost of gravel

Street lighting: – no increase

Road Betterment

01-4319-730 - \$151,000 State portion for next year

01-4319-731 - Line should read \$190,000

Brian asked about new monies from the new federal bill. Paul has not heard anything yet.

Warrant Articles:

\$70,000 to go into Highway Equipment Capital Reserve acct.

\$10,000 to go into Non- capital reserve acct.

Transfer & Recycling Station:

01-4324-110 - Increase from 36 hours to 40 hours per week.

01-4324-111 – Increase wages based on the change in placement on the pay scale.

01-4324-112 – Increase from 25 hours to 30 hours per week and increase on the pay scale.

01-4324-113 – Increase wages based on the change in placement on the pay scale.

01-4324-391 – Increase of \$200 to mow twice a year

01-4324-661 - Increase of \$1,000 due to price increases

01-4324-800 - Increase of 3.2%

01-4324-801 – Increase of 3.2%

01-4324-808 – Increase of \$1,200 due to increase cost

Brian asked about Town's commitment to NNRA. Discussion about their services and if there might be another economical option for the removal of tires. Ron will look into it.
