Payment: Payment is not due at the time of application. It will be due prior to the Certificate of Right to Inter being issued by the Cemetery Trustees.

Part of the purchase price includes General Care Funds. The principal of such funds is permanently placed on deposit with the Gilmanston Trustees of Trust Funds. The annual income from such funds is used for the reasonable and practical care of the cemetery. Additional General Care Funds can be contributed at the time of sale or at a later date. Such donations are deductible under Internal Revenue Codes and greatly appreciated as many of the older burials did not include care funds. Additional Care funds shall be due for multiple interments in a single grave in accordance with the then current Regulations.

PURCHASER SIGNATURE

Grave Owners should notify the Trustees in writing whenever their contact information changes. In addition, if the ownership of the grave changes for any reason such as by death of the owner, the Trustees must be notified of the transfer of ownership through the estate process.

The Resale of any Cemetery Grave or Right to Inter shall be only to the Town of Gilmanton and abandoned graves may be declared forfeited in accordance with RSA 289:18.

Upon receipt of a completed application the Trustees shall confirm the availability of the requested grave(s) and issue a Certificate of Right to Inter. The Certificate along with a statement for the total cost of the grave shall be returned to the Purchaser. The signed certificate along with full payment shall be returned to the Trustees within 30days or the graves shall be deemed again available for sale.

Once a Certificate and payment have been returned timely to the Trustees, they shall sign and record the Certificate, returning the original to the Purchaser for their records. The Trustees shall also then order the installation of the granite corner posts.
