A. **Review of Minutes** – July 12, 2022

Member Gilman was happy to report the Tom Howe Barn and conservation area is now on the State's Register of Historic Places. She has sent a grant application to Moose Plate and is now working on a document for Seven to Save nomination through the NH Preservation Alliance. There is no money but instead State wide media coverage. If selected, it would help with grants.
