Chair Hackley and Vice Chair Hopkins will meet with BOS to have a discussion about the Forest Maintenance Fund.

Member Dombrowski gave a quick trails update stating Ron Klemarczyk will be cutting the east summit on Monday depending on the weather and it should take a day. Mr. Klemarczyk and Mr. Allen had walked the trails.

Chair Hackley went over the operating budget, trails budget and conservation fund. The budget and funds will be put on the next month agenda. Member Dombrowski stated will send a thank you letter to Rich Maher. Chair Hackley asked if the agenda can be sent to him ahead of the sending out to the commission.
