1. Approve meeting minutes 10/4/22

- Approved with Rich's suggestion that we add 'Trails Subcommittee to minutes.
- 20 ft strip. Did Gary say he owns that strip? Yes.

3. Trail Updates:

Cogswell Trail-Completed work

- Rich and Thomie dug five holes, placed posts for signs
- Signs completed and installed.

New trail development on Cogswell

- Investigating alternative routes to the Cogswell East Summit
- Rich investigated route from west but encountered water, so had to veer back to existing road/trail. He did discover an alternative route from the East peak that comes out at the red trail. Frank and Rich to walk the trail to East Cog on Saturday, November 5. 11:00 AM for East Peak

Summit Update

- Ron Klemarczyk available for summit work on Monday, November 14
- How will we access?
 - Perkins road may be most efficient way to access
 - Need to walk through Perkins access to confirm it's viable
 - Planning to extent the Saturday, November 5. 9:00 AM for Perkins access hike to investigate Perkins Rd

- Since this will benefit snowmobiling as well (view), can we engage Snowmobile Association for assistance/vehicle/4-wheeler

3. Update on Trail Monitoring-Lori & Thomie

- Thomie went on a trail monitoring hike on 2 separate trails. The amount of info Thomie had given for Cogs trails was about the same as what was collected on the hike (i.e. boundary markers)
- Owners were not on the walk, but they were alerted that there was a monitor hike and informed if there was anything amiss on the trail
- Thomie submitted Cogswell monitors report to Bre
- SPNF info about our trail
 - Thomie: we should not do SPNFs work. We should provide the basic monitoring info
 - Bill Foster has already done many of the things that SPNF does
 - We won't go above and beyond unless we're specifically engaged by CC for help
