#### Attendees: Tommie, Rich, Chris, Frank, Lori

- 1. Approve meeting minutes 11/01/22
  - Move to approve from Thomie, Lori seconds, all approve
- 2. Trail Updates:
  - Cogswell Summit
    - Cogswell main/center summit clearing
    - Opening a portion of the summit, triggered desire to open additional view
    - Ron cuts very deliberately, safely, methodically, efficiently
    - Trees neatly laid down
    - Ron recommended throwing brush over the cliff/into ravine
    - Contact fire ranger (boy scout camp) to alert them that there is a large amount of brush in one spot. Not to move it, but to make fire department aware:
      - Action: follow up with Ron regarding brush debris
      - Action: Remaining brush work
        - Only a problem for 3-4 years
        - Remaining work; 2 people, 1-2 hours
        - And 1-2 hours of clean up at summit (around old picnic table)
      - Action: Broken tree Frank reported (and that he shared pics from closer to <u>upper slope</u>) should be cleaned up
      - Action: Spring need to identify a tree climber to cut suckers off (2) trees that could obstruct view as the leaves come in
        - people were split 50/50 on keeping these 2 trees versus taking them down
      - Action: Rich, Tree down near Lou Lane or snack shack to remove
    - Bench location identified, facing SE toward Prospect Mt. Nice, secluded area
      - Rich would like to donate the bench
        - Composite 'wood', Big Jim's has good options
      - Ron's bill for the work came in under budget
        - Gary & Mahr family funded the work
      - Email came to GCC asking if subcommittees instead of buying on their own, there could be entities that the town would buy from on behalf of the subcommittees
      - Action: Engage Gary about dedication (Tom Howe??)
    - Jones farm trail update
      - Frank reports that some remnants of camping / trash / sleeping bags
