H. OTHER BUSINESS/PUBLIC COMMENT

- a. Warrant Article Discussion
 - Changes made at the last meeting to the definitions of "warehouse" and "commercial storage facility" were reviewed, as well as the table of Uses. Members discussed the changes and decided to proceed with the updates as written. The changes were to differentiate between commercial and private storage, as well as place storage building- noncommercial on the table of uses.
 - Updates to Article VII. Non-conforming uses, lots & structures were reviewed. The changes were to allow a non-conforming structure be rebuilt in the same footprint without having to receive a variance. Members also felt the requirement in paragraph C.1-c stating a septic design on a non-conforming lot could not receive a waiver, could be removed.
 - The building inspector recommended adding stronger language to the Article III:C titled Obnoxious Uses. Ms. Daigneault explained this article was being utilize to

enforce properties with extensive exterior garage or junk. She presented an example for wording. Members discussed and would come to the next meeting with comments and proposed language for the ordinance.
