

**SAWYER LAKE VILLAGE DISTRICT
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' MEETING
March 22, 2018**

Present: Bob Dow, Rich Bakos, Steve Chmielecki, Rich Adams, and Paula Adams

Meeting came to order at 6:00 PM. Minutes from the February 15, 2018, meeting read, accepted and seconded.

- Dam: Rich Adams presented the new proposal from NH Dams for approval from the commissioners. They will take care of data being sent to the State Dam Bureau. The cost of the service will be about \$2,000. This will be brought to the voters at the Annual District Meeting on April 7, 2018. Kingsbury Landscaping will mow the beaches. The commissioners will take care of the brush at the dam. More trees will have to come down at the dam.
- Beaches: No business
- Roads: It's been quite busy taking care of roads. Hopefully things will quiet down. We have mud season again.
- Treasurer's Report: MS 535 accepted by state. The final form needs to be signed by the commissioners and sent back to state. Will transfer \$10,000 to Operating Account. We have spent \$21,618.42 on roads to-date. This time last year we spent \$15,045.00. We find- tuned the budget for 2018. We had a few emergencies this year because of the weather. We owe \$120,000 on the dam note. The Commissioners will bring a budget of \$87,576.00 for approval at the Annual Meeting in April.
