

**SAWYER LAKE VILLAGE DISTRICT
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' MEETING
June 18, 2020**

Present: Bob Dow, Rich Bakos, Steve Chmieleki, Rich Adams, and Paula Adams

Meeting came to order at 6:00 PM. The minutes from the February 13, 2020, meeting notes were read, seconded, and accepted.

- Dam: Went over the improvements for the dam. The big issue is the culvert on Route 107. This is a problem for the town. It has been brought to their attention many times. We have a new representative for the dam at the state.
- Beaches: There was a disagreement at Beach 5 about a new stake placed on the beach. The owners beside the beach claim it is their property. The beaches were surveyed February 4, 2006. There is a surveyor's pin on the property line. This is the correct border. Considering having this beach surveyed again. This cost would be charged to beaches.
- Roads: There has been a lot of ditching and road work. Putting $\frac{3}{4}$ inch stone on the roads has made a difference with pot holes. There aren't as many. It's very dry but the roads seem to be holding up.
- Treasurer's Report: The District has spent \$30,480.54 to-date. The roads are under budget at this time. Will ask MLB that is mowing the beaches and the dam to break the bill down into beaches and the dam.
