

**SAWYER LAKE VILLAGE DISTRICT  
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' MEETING  
August 20, 2020**

Present: Bob Dow, Rich Bakos, Steve Chiemleki, Rich Adams, and Paula Adams

Meeting came to order at 6:00 PM. The minutes from the July 16, 2020, meeting notes were read, seconded, and accepted.

- Dam: Bob Carter of NH Dams attended the meeting explaining what work is being done and remains for our six- year plan to address the Letter of Deficiency. He also explained that the state has revised the regulations for dams, and therefore, the SLVD dam has been deemed out of code at this time. NH Dams is working with the state to come up with a plan to bring the dam up to current regulations.
- Roads: There is a motor home jammed into the woods on Fox Drive. We are looking into having it removed. The roads are very dry and won't stay packed because of the cars and ATV's.
- Beaches: No business
- Treasurer's Report: The recent storms have caused lots of wash outs. The roads are significantly over last year's Road Budget. At the annual meeting we should discuss bumping up the budget for the roads. Also the cost of insurance on the building will be rising. The insurance hasn't changed in 18 years. Steve will look into liability and if the rafts can have ladders.

The Treasurer's Report was seconded and accepted.

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- Open Forum: There was a question brought forward about the culvert over near 338 Hemlock Drive. Every rain storm it runs over the road and washes it out causing it to run off into the lake. Bob knows about this and it is on the agenda to be fixed. The property across the street has been clear-cut causing the run-off.

It was also asked what the classification of the dam is now? The person was informed it now considered at the highest danger level.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:50 PM. This was seconded and accepted.
