## SAWYER LAKE ILLAGE DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' MONTHLY MEETING Thursday, November 17, 2022

Present: Richard Adams, David Leboeuf, Thomas LeMien, Bob Dow, and Paula Adams

Meeting came to order at 6:00 PM. The minutes from the October 20, 2022, meeting were read, accepted, and seconded.

- e Dam: All the boards are out and stored away. Bob mentioned this would be a good time to clean, brush, and paint the channel for the boards. Rich has heard more about the grant. It seems we are eligible for \$270,000 and we have to put in \$30,000 for a total of \$300,000. We will have to think about raising our Dam Budget or taking it out of out of our cash reserve. Rich said one of the things that the grant required was that the District have workmen's comp. Rich explained we don't have any employees, so we don't have workmen's comp. He explained that the District would make sure anyone that was hired would have workmen's comp. The other item was enough liability insurance. Rich spoke with Primex and it looks like we have enough coverage. He's just waiting for the rider from Primex. Rich also explained that the agreement is like reading the tax code. He feels that it would be a good idea to have a lawyer look at it. Rich will look into getting a Municipal lawyer to go over the documents. He also feels we should think about upping the amount we put into the budget for legal fees?
- Beaches: Rich received a compliment on the great job that has been done to clean up the beaches. Some of the boats that were removed and put behind the district building have been retrieved by their owners.
- Roads: Bob took the debris blower to the Wood Drive and Hemlock. There were tons blew the ditch lines out and they now look Iris Ave. There was so much silt it had to

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- Roads Continued: They also brought four Iris. They also went up to Deer Drive and repaired some culverts. He also explained the cost of the sand and salt. Steve is looking forward to another successful year. A question was asked about how much sand would be used in a winter. Bob said it all depended a lot of snow, not as much sand is used.
- Treasurer's Report: There are no outstanding bills, except for the ones brought in at the meeting. We're in good shape financially. We have enough money for emergencies. All the bills and the bank statements have been signed by the commissioners. A funds transfer will be made to the Operating Account. A question was asked how the Grant money is received. The bills we receive will be submitted to the DES. We will not be getting a bag of money!
