## welcome to the COGSWELL MOUNTAIN CONSERVATION AREA Gilmanton, New Hampshire ~

The parcels that comprise the Cogswell Mountain Conservation area are owned by four different landowners, and total 519 acres. They are protected forever by conservation easements held by the Town of Gilmanton acting through its Conservation Commission, or by the Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests.

The four distinct conservation easements all allow for public access for low impact, non-motorized outdoor recreational and educational activities. Activities such as camping, hunting, or trail work would require permission from the landowner. The use of snowmobiles is negotiated between the landowner and the Gilmanton Snowmobile Association.

Please remember these lands are privately owned and treat them with respect and appreciation.
