- The Deputy Town Clerk/Tax Collector position has been posted on the website. We have had some interest & I intend to onboard mid-October. I do not want to hire someone in the midst of this schedule.
- o I do not intend to make any drastic changes through the rest of the year. With hiring a new Deputy, adjustments of other responsibilities, & the Election in March, I will be considering extended hours.
- O We anticipate FOUR Elections in 2024. <u>Dates have not been confirmed by the Secretary of State!!!</u>
 Per RSA, I would anticipate one in January, before South Carolina. Town Election as normal in March, State Primary in September, & State General in November.
