

**Town of Gilmanton, New Hampshire  
ORDINANCE REGULATING  
SNOW OBSTRUCTION AND REMOVAL**

In accordance with and under the authority of New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, Chapters 41:11 and 47:17, VII, the Town of Gilmanton Board of Selectmen hereby establishes the following ordinance regarding Snow Obstruction and Removal.

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this ordinance is to protect the safety, health, and welfare of the general public and to regulate the use of the municipal roads, sidewalks, and parking areas within the Town of Gilmanton.

**Section I  
DEFINITIONS**

The following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

**PERSON** - Any person, vehicle owner, firm, partnership, association, corporation, company, or organization of any kind.

**Section II**

**PROHIBITED ACTS**

- A. No person shall put, place, or store or cause to be put, placed, or stored snow or ice which has been removed from private property onto any public road, sidewalk, or parking area within the Town of Gilmanton.
- B. No person shall purposely or knowingly put or place, or cause to be put or placed, any snow, ice, or other debris so as to cover a fire hydrant so as to make it inaccessible for immediate use in the event of a fire. For the purpose of this section "person" excludes agents of the state or any political subdivision engaged in the operation of snow removal from the traveled portion of any highway or the adjacent sidewalk or parking area.

**Section III  
PENALTIES**

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and subject to a penalty in the amount of \$100.00 if an individual, and \$500.00 for any other person.
