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Energy Committee Introduction

The Town of Gilmanton Energy Committee serves the town in an advisory capacity and reports to the Board of Selectmen. The mission of the committee is to consider how energy is used in Gilmanton, particularly by municipal services and facilities, and to advise the selectmen and school board about opportunities to achieve a higher level of energy efficiency, education, savings, and renewable energy use to support a more sustainable future for Gilmanton.

The committee's areas of focus include, but are not limited to: options for energy efficiency, exploring feasibility of energy production and identifying potential resources to assist the town in a cost-efficient manner. The Committee is also working with the Gilmanton School's Director of Maintenance to see where energy consumption can be reduced and whether or not a renewable energy source is viable to reduce the school's carbon footprint as well as cost to the taxpayers.

Additionally the committee will educate citizens about energy related topics for their homes, businesses and the town as a whole. These topics consist of but are not limited to electric vehicles, solarization of homes and businesses, energy efficiency within their homes, reduction of certain energy sources such as fossil fuels as well as the overall methods of reducing the carbon footprint for the town and its residents.

Town of Gilmanton Baseline Energy Report

The Gilmanton Energy Committee has prepared this Town of Gilmanton Baseline Energy Report, documenting energy consumption and costs (electricity, oil, natural gas, diesel, propane, other) for the Municipal Buildings and Vehicles for the years 2017, 2018, and 2019.

The objective of this Baseline Energy Report is to establish the current baseline energy consumption and associated costs, in order to identify opportunities for improvement (i.e., reduced consumption and decreased costs).

Scope of Assessment

The following buildings, facilities, and lighting are covered by this report:

- General Government (Academy Building [Corners], Old Town Hall [Iron Works]);
- Police Department (Safety Building [Police Department], vehicles);
- Fire Department (Safety Building [Fire Department], Iron Works Fire Department Station, vehicles);
- Highway Administration (Highway Department Buildings [Stage Road, White Oaks Road, Allens Mills Road, and Church Street], vehicles, and street lighting);
- Transfer Station (Transfer Station and vehicles);
- Parks and Recreation (Crystal Lake Park); and
- Gilmanton Library (Corners Town Library).

Method and Limitations

The energy consumption data presented in this report were compiled in cooperation with the staff at each of the represented departments. This data represents the best information (energy bills, receipts, etc.) available at the date of this writing. Energy consumption and associated costs were not always readily available, particularly for gasoline and diesel. Therefore, the costs and consumption figures underestimate the actual quantities. The information presented herein is preliminary and will be updated as additional information becomes available. Even with these limitations, the information is sufficient to provide a preliminary energy consumption baseline.






Dollar Amount vs. Department






Dollar Amount vs. Department




Volume (Gallons) vs. Department

Volume (Gallons) vs. Department










Electricity Dollar Amount vs. Department






Propane Dollar Amount vs. Department



Oil Dollar Amount




Oil Volume (Gallons)


Gasoline/Diesel Dollar Amount (Gallons)





Dollar Amount vs. Department



The total reported town energy expenditure for 2019 was \$108,843.87. This represents 2.98% of the town operating budget. The total reported town energy expenditure for 2018 was \$131,688.62. This represents 3.60% of the town operating budget. The total reported town energy expenditure for 2017 was \$84,753.60. This represents 2.26% of the town operating budget.

Discussion

The town spends more on electricity than any other energy source. Investigating opportunities for electricity savings is a high priority. Nearly all of the town's energy sources are fossil-fuel based. Many of the town's other energy sources could be replaced with renewably generated electricity.

Recommendations

Based on this evaluation, the Gilmanton Energy Committee recommends the following actions:

- Conduct a comprehensive energy audit of all municipal buildings and facilities to identify options for improving energy efficiency and potential savings. Identify opportunities for transitioning heating and vehicle fuels to electric power.
- Investigate grants/rebates available for those suggested upgrades. The Committee will assist in that process.
- Institute a system to monitor the town's annual energy usage and costs.
- Explore the options for installing solar photovoltaic panels to serve some or all municipal buildings, vehicle, and street lighting needs.
- Assess options for electric vehicle transition for daily driver vehicles where possible.
