The requested deed would clarify and correct the Town's 1997 Quitclaim Deed to prior owner, David Ladd, in which the land was not clearly identified. The requested deed would confirm Sapiro and Wilson as the owners of this land, for which they and prior owners paid significant funds to acquire, and on which they have paid property taxes for decades. The Town has already been treating this area as owned by Sapiro and Wilson in terms of its approval of forest management plans they have submitted for Current Use enrollment. The Town also has collected timber taxes for forestry activities carried out on this land by Sapiro and Wilson.
