- 12 Approval of Minutes
- 13 MOTION: On a motion by Bob Burdett and seconded by Neil Roberts it was voted unanimously to
- approve the minutes of 06-22-2020 accepted as written.

15 Income Projection Spreadsheet-

- o Projecting a positive cash flow of \$13,478.00
- Note- One equity, Occidental Petroleum, virtually suspend their dividend. They went from \$56.80 down to .72cents
- o Total Income monies- \$227,726
- Total Principal- \$472,197.24
- Total Portfolio Value-\$699,923.51
- 22 Chairman notes that overall things are pretty good and he is still working on getting the year to date
- 23 performance to a benchmark, it seems that the page is under construction and unavailable at this time.
- 24 Fidelity Spreadsheet- This sheet represents activity as of the close of business Friday.
- Overall, it looks like things are on the rebound but energy stocks are down. Health care stocks are
- 26 doing quite well;
 - ABBVIE is up 112%
 - Johnson & Johnson is up 52%
- Kimberly Clark is heavily involved in paper goods and is up 64%
- 30 Pfizer is up 83%
 - AT & T is still down but they are bringing their debt load down after the Time Warner acquisition

33 New Business-

34 Stephen Hopkins spoke to the Investment Strategy that was given out to the Board members.

- 35 Page one; it is worth noting the difference between stocks and energy. The current portfolio has a
- 36 reasonable amount of energy exposure.
- 37 The next page is key for the Trustees, speaking to interest rates and how low they are and how low
- 38 they are likely to be. The hope is that our CD rates hold well at Meredith Savings because it's hard to
- 39 see where we are going to pick up any yield from here, and the likelihood of higher cooperate tax rate
- 40 coming up in the future.
- Things to think about: Low rates, higher taxes, pressure on oil companies, and in general what kind of
- 42 environment is that going to be for us.
- 43 Items for future discussion: Alternatives to energy, like infrastructure; construction, utilities, toll roads,
- places where infrastructure is rented but privately owned for public use.
- 45 Overall discussion among the Trustees-
- 46 STAG Industrial has held up well and is a high yield holding, Medical Properties Trust, MPW they have
- 47 medical properties, hospitals. STAG does industrial warehousing, industrial buildings, they own some
- 48 Amazon properties.
- 49 Further discussion on real estate- repurposing and not as much growth but items such as warehousing,
- and medical properties will continue to thrive, Walgreens background, IBM & RIT MLP. MPW-Medical
- 51 Properties Trust was collecting 96 % of their rent, as was STAG and WP Carey, equities rebound, and
- 52 the impact from the Federal Reserve.
- 53 Valuations for the following companies;
- 54 MPW- The price-earnings are 22.33, Market Cap is 9.72 billion, Yield is 5.88%, Trading in a 52-week
- range-12.35 to 24.29, right now it's at 18.75- middle of the range.
- 56 STAG- Just under 5 billion, the 52-week range is 17.54 to 34.09, currently trading at 32.22, Yield is
- 57 4.14%
- 58 The portfolio has significant energy exposure; ideas to diversify and possibly look into infrastructure at
- 59 the following meeting. Stocks that do well tend to be ones with items that people need to survive.
- 60 Information will be sent out between meetings, further research and discussion will take place at the
- 61 following meeting.
