- 16 Chairman Buchholz-All the bills are in for 2017, there is a positive cash flow of \$11, 482.00, so we are in
- 17 good shape.
- 18 Total income- Sitting at \$188,946.00
- 19 **Total Principal** In good shape at \$443,321.00

- 21 Chairman Buchholz- Looking at the most recent Fidelity report which was printed as of the close of
- business Friday, it is interesting because at the end of December, looking at the income projection
- 23 sheets on the left, ABBVIE closed the year out at \$52,900 and as of close of business Friday, it is at
- 24 \$57,238.00, so it has risen over \$4,000.00.
- 25 The thought would be since our total principle is sitting at \$443, 321.00 and ABBVIE is at \$57,000,
- we're at least \$13,000.00 over the 10%, so it might be a good idea to bring it down to the ten percent
- 27 by selling approximately \$13,000 and letting it sit in cash because the market is going to correct and it
- would be nice to have siting there and be able to sell high and buy low.
